

If after gathering all of the required information, you are approved for a pet, a written agreement will be drawn up providing approval and outlining your obligations.

Makes 8 servings

YOU WILL NEED

1 cup butter softened½ cup icing / powdered sugar

½ cup corn starch

Pinch salt

2 cups flour

DIRECTIONS

- Pre-heat oven to 160 degrees
 Celsius.
- Beat butter until creamy.
- Sift icing sugar, corn starch, salt and flour 4 times.

- Add to creamed butter a little at a time and work in with a wooden spoon as long as possible.
- Move to a lightly floured flat surface and knead till mixture cracks slightly.
- Pat gently to 1/3" thickness.
- Cut with your favourite Christmas cutters.
- Place on ungreased cookie sheets.
- Bake in pre-heated oven for approximately 10-12 minutes, be sure not to let them brown.
