

PEPPERMINT LOG



INGREDIENTS:

- 1 packet of malt biscuits
- 1 packet of Crown mints
- 1 tin of condensed milk
- 1/4 cup coconut

METHOD:

Step 1 - Process biscuits until you get a fine crumb.

Step 2 - Crush mints into small pieces and add biscuits

Step 3 - Add condensed milk, coconut and mix well.

Step 4 - Using cling wrap, roll into a log and freeze approximately 30 - 60 minutes

Step 5 - Take out of plastic and roll in coconut and slice. Store in the fridge.

NOTE: Add 3 tablespoons of Cocoa into step 3 for a chocolate flavour!
