HOT CROSS BUNS



INGREDIENTS:

- 25 g butter
- 225g strong plain flour
- 1 tsp salt
- 6 g fast-action dry yeast
- 40 g caster sugar
- 55 g mixed dried fruit
- 25 g mixed peel
- 1 tsp mixed spice
- 150 ml skim milk

METHOD:

- 1. Preheat your oven to 220°C (200°C fan-forced).
- 2. Put the margarine, sieved flour and salt into a large bowl and rub into a fine mixture that resembles breadcrumbs.
- 3.Stir in the yeast, sugar, fruit, peel and spice. Warm the milk until tepid, pour it into the bowl, and mix together into a soft dough.
- 4. Place the dough onto a floured surface and knead until elastic and no longer sticky. Shape into 8 buns and place them onto a greased baking sheet.
- 5.Cover them with lightly oiled cling film and leave in a warm place for around 45 minutes, until almost doubled in size.
- 6.To make the crosses: Blend the margarine with the flour and 4 tablespoons of water. Remove the cling film from the buns and pipe the mixture across them.
- 7. Pop buns in the oven for 15 minutes or until golden brown and cooked through.
- 8.To make the glaze: Gently warm the sugar and milk together. Brush it over the buns, and pop them back into the oven for another 2 minutes.

GLAZE:

- 25 g butter
- 55 g plain flour

CROSSES:

- 25 g butter
- 55 g plain flour
