A MESSAGE FROM **OUR CEO**

As the year draws to a close, I am delighted with the progress and achievements which A2P has made over the past twelve months.

The Board have approved a 10-year development program that includes 100 new purpose-built homes, for those most in need. Importantly, a further \$1.1m has been committed this financial year, to maintenance and capital upgrades to our existing housing portfolio. Our partnership with the State Government has resulted in unlocking capital funding available from the NDIS. The funding will be used to develop further disability housing options for members of the community.

In addition to this, in partnership with the Department of Human Services we completed 44 projects to upgrade homes at 21 properties for tenants aged over 65 years old. These works included painting rooms; kitchen and bathroom upgrades; installing blinds, roller shutters and grab rails.

Finally, I would like to take this opportunity to draw attention to how incredibly proud and constantly amazed I am of our staff, who have worked incredibly hard in another difficult year, to deliver compassionate and first-class service to our tenants.

On behalf of the team at A2P, we wish everyone a wonderful and happy end to 2022 and look forward to the year ahead.

A VISION OF 'HOPE'

Murray Bridge tenant, Mia, has recently created this artwork for A2P's "Reflect" Reconciliation Action Plan (RAP). She started with the idea to paint an Aboriginal woman sitting by a river, looking into the water and seeing the reflection. Once she got started, Mia went on to paint a "reflection of a white woman sharing the vision with an Aboriginal woman. They see beyond today, what both races are capable of doing, positively, and joining together to make that come true."



The RAP's Reflect theme gave Mia's picture direction. "Water always represents emotion. When it's positive emotion, what I'm trying to put into the painting, it makes it stronger. It has its roots in, not only culture, but in the Dreaming ...and the hope... So that's what the water is: the emotion of that."

"My painting is a way I send out the emotion, get it reflected back, and what I learn from that helps me grow. It's very spiritual, my paintings." Mia often paints women "I see beauty in women that most of them aren't even aware of".

CHRISTMAS ROCKY

This easy no-bake recipe takes only minutes to prepare, but it looks and tastes amazing. Treat your family and friends to this delicious Christmas rocky road made from scratch.

INGREDIENTS:

- 100g white chocolate
- 100g milk chocolate, chopped
- 100g mini oreo cookies, halved
- 100g raspberry jellies, chopped
- · 50g pink and white marshmallows, halved
- 40g cherry ripe bars, coarsely chopped

METHOD:

Step 1

Line a baking tray with baking paper.

Step 2

Melt the white and milk chocolates separately in heatproof bowls over a saucepan of simmering water. Stir with a metal spoon until chocolate melts. Pour in a marbled pattern over the lined tray.

Step 3

Sprinkle chocolate with cookies, jellies, marshmallows and cherry ripe. Set aside for 1 hour or until completely set. Break into shards to serve.
